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REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Regarding

Municipal Solid Waste Treatment

The Government of Suriname (GoS), represented by the Ministry of Public Works (in cooperation with the Ministry of Natural Resources, the Ministry of Spatial Planning and Environment and the Ministry of Regional Development and Sports), intends to solve the waste problem in Suriname in an environmentally friendly way. In this context, the GoS is seeking for private investors in a Public Private Partnership (PPP) cooperation to set up a modern waste processing facility in Suriname. The investors will use appropriate existing PPP models for realization and financing.

The Ministry of Public Works invites interested companies to submit an **Expression of Interest** for the aforementioned facility. The GoS recognizes that the extent of financing, development and operational expertise may require bundling of parties in consortia of various forms.

The involvement of the GoS is limited to providing the necessary permits and the land lease. Furthermore, the GoS will purchase the generated electric power in the case of waste to energy after signing the Purchase Power Agreement (PPA). The waste treatment facility must be capable of handling municipal solid waste according to modern international acceptable principals. Municipal solid waste to be defined as waste generated by households, commercial establishments, public and private institutions, government agencies and other sources. This waste stream included food and yard wastes, waste from sawmills, grinding flour (and other leftovers) from rice processing (rice husk and straw) and a multitude of durable and nondurable products and packaging collected at the existing dumpsite Ornamibo, dumpsite Nickerie and Marowijne. However, any growth of waste during time of operation should be incorporated.

The waste treatment facility will incorporate all following processes: waste inlet, storage and handling, processing to prepare waste, including waste reduction by removing metals, combustion, air-pollution control, energy production and connection to existing local electricity grid, residue (ash) handling and sanitary landfill. The facility should be capable of processing the entire solid waste production from the country.

Waste collection is not included; it will be offered separately and should include waste from greater Paramaribo and other districts. The location for the waste treatment facility will be at Ornamibo near the existing landfill or elsewhere in the near vicinity of Paramaribo. Small facilities can be developed in the districts Nickerie and Marowijne. Initial Period of Operation will be 30 years, which is also negotiable.

All Expressions of Interest should include:

- Introduction of the Company
- All similar project realized in the past , including financial details (cost, revenues)
- Financial statements regarding the Company
- Installations to be proposed (headlines)
- Business plan (headlines)

In the assessment of the received submissions, considerations will be given to technical competence, qualifications and experience, local and regional experience on similar assignments, financial capability and existing commitments.


Finally, a short list of three to six applicants will be provided with a full TOR and invited to submit a detailed technical proposal including a financial proposal regarding participation in the intended Public Private Partnership.

One hard copy and one soft copy of the requested EOI must be received at the Ministry of Public Works not later than 11:00 hours (local time Suriname) on November 30th 2021. The sealed envelope containing the submission should include the name and address of the applicant and shall be clearly marked "**Expression of Interest – Municipal Solid Waste Treatment**".

The GoS reserves the right to accept or reject late applications or to cancel invitations partially or in it's entirely. The GoS will not except EOIs received after the submission date and will not give preferential treatment to consortia formed by or consisting of GoS owned entities.



